Grapes were hand picked into 12 Kg boxes and selected at the sorting table. Fermentation occurred in stainless steel lagares with temperature control and traditional maceration. Aged for 18 months in new French oak barrels.

**Tasting Notes**  
From 2016 harvest we have selected our best grapes of Aragonez from Herdade da Malhadinha Nova to elaborate this special single variety wine which presents a deep and intense ruby colour. From a strong aromatic intensity, it presents on the nose aromas of plum in syrup, a hint of spices and fig jam. In the mouth is exuberant but well balanced with present but subtle tannins. The final taste is lengthy.
