

FLOR DAS TECEDEIRAS ROSÉ 2018

Made from three of the most typical Douro grapes: Tinta Roriz, Touriga Nacional and Touriga Franca, this rosé is produced with loving care at Quinta das Tecedeiras' riverside winery in the heart of the Douro valley. This wine introduces itself with notes of vibrant and fresh red fruit on the nose and palate. These give way to a welcoming sensation of balanced acidity on the finish. A fruit-forward, elegant wine, best suited to lighter dishes such as salads, fish and seafood, white meats and vegetarian dishes in general.

TERROIR

Bathed by the waters of the Douro's left bank in the renowned area of São João da Pesqueira, the Tecedeiras vineyards owe their name to the nuns who in centuries past wove linen from the flax plants here. The soils here are schist and the terracing north and east facing, starting at the water's edge and rising to about 190m.

TASTING NOTES

Colour Rose-pink, with a pretty tinge of violet.

Nose Good intensity, smooth, red fruit (cherry and strawberry) with discreet herbaceous character.

Palate Creamy, balanced acidity, intense mouthfeel with notes of red fruit. A balanced, friendly wine with a persistent finish.

VINIFICATION

Manual harvest. Hand selected grapes on the vine. De-stemming, brief maceration and skin contact with swift pressing. Fermentation in in temperature-controlled stainless steel vats. Remains on lies until February 2019.

FROM CELLAR TO TABLE

Ideal for fish and seafood, but also for lighter vegetarian dishes and all sorts of Summer salads.
